



NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

WEST DEVON BOROUGH COUNCIL AMENDMENT ORDER NO 1 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that WEST DEVON BOROUGH COUNCIL proposes to make an Amendment Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which is to implement an Amendment Order containing provisions as set out in the schedule to the order.

- (a) That Abbey car park be changed from a long stay to a short stay car park with the short stay parking tariff applied.
- (b) That parking permits be no longer valid for use in Abbey Car Park, with the exception of Dolvin Road residents and the parents of St Rumons Schoolchildren
